

# Wines by the Glass

## Sauvignon Blanc

**MonteVina, 2007, California-** Classic cool climate with characteristics like melon, lemon and grapefruit flavors are balanced by a light grassy note.

**Clifton Road, 2005, Marlborough, New Zealand-** Abounds with ripe, tropical aromas and flavors typical of classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

## Chardonnay

**Tobin James “Radiance”, 2008, Monterey County-** Firm and well bodied; pear banana, and nut flavors; finish lingers through supple oak tannins, cream, and hints of vanilla.

**Beaulieu Vineyard “Coastal Estates,” 2008, California-** Golden apple and tropical fruit flavors with tropical vanilla oak nuances.

**Paul Dolan, 2008, Mendocino County-** Organically grown grapes with aromas of pear and winter citrus fruit with hints of creamy vanilla spice.

**Simi, 2008, Sonoma County-** Aromas of peach and apricot accented notes of vanilla lightly spiced with hints of clove, cinnamon and toasty; citrus flavors are accented ripe apricot and hints of spice and oak; long, lingering finish.

**Trefethen, 2007, Oak Knoll District, Napa Valley-** Aromas of mango and spice with hints of tarragon and flavors of creamy lemon, apple, and smoky oak underscored by bright mineral qualities.

**Merryvale, 2007, Carneros-** Aromas of hazelnut, tropical fruit and ripe apple are framed by crisp minerality and sweet toasty oak. The wine is rich and creamy with a lingering finish.

**Rombauer, 2008, Carneros-** Aromas of pears, peaches, and tropical fruit with hints of spice; flavors of fruit and vanilla; crisp acidity and a long, lingering finish.

## Other Whites

**Ruffino “Lumina” Pinot Grigio, 2009, Venezia, Italy-** Tropical fruity aromas with hints of golden delicious apple; fresh, crisp, and well-structured.

**Trimbach Riesling, 2007, Ribeauvillé, Alsace, France-** Hint of mineral flavor associated with good ripeness; flavors of ripe fruit - white peaches, quince and lemon, with good ripe acidity in the clean, lingering finish.

**L’Estandon, Rosé, 2009, Cotes De Provence, France-** Aromas of raspberry, white and yellow peaches and citrus fruits with a lingering acidity.

**Chandon, Brut, California-** Exhibits apple and pear flavors with a hint of spice that builds to a soft, dry finish.

**Perrier-Jouet Grand Brut, NV, Epernay, Champagne**

Aromas of green apple, pineapple, and white peach, with rich flavors of fresh butter brioche, and shortbread.

## Pinot Noir

**Main Street, 2008, Napa Valley-** Ripe black cherry and mocha aromas with cedar, spice and vanilla. Sleek and supple on the palate, the wine is brimming with bright black cherry and spice with a hint of mint.

**Laetitia Estate, 2008, Arroyo Grande Valley-** Dark mulberry tones and aromas of cranberry and spice; this wine is rich and medium-bodied. Youthful flavors of pomegranate, sandalwood and red cherries.

## Merlot

**Main Street, 2006, California-** Juicy black cherry and plum flavors and just a hint of vanilla and cedar in the finish. Lush, rich, and remarkably smooth with ripe, juicy fruit and mouth-watering acidity.

**Franciscan, 2005, Napa Valley-** Intense blackberry and black cherry aromas, accented by vanilla-toasted oak with hints of cassis; supple and ripe blackberry, black cherry, toasted oak and vanilla flavors.

## Zinfandel

**Tobin James Cellars “Ballistic,” 2007, Paso Robles-** Over-the-top jammy blackberry and raspberry flavors join up with chocolaty oak and a bit of pepper spice as the fruit fades into the warm finish.

**Rombauer, 2008, California-** Full bodied, fruit forward; aromas of black cherry and plum, with a light, spicy character; a dark berry fruit finish lingers on the palate.

## Cabernet Sauvignon
